

From the Missions Ministry—Christian Support Center

A Mission our church supports regularly is the Christian Support Center. A partnership of churches in Plainfield (Plainfield Federation of Churches) formed the Christian Support Center. Currently it is headquartered at St. Mark’s Episcopal Church (710 E. Buchanan St.) in Plainfield and is run by volunteers. The Center provides many services including a food bank and a clothing bank that includes new and gently used clothing for men, women, children, and infants.

Financially struggling families in Hendricks County facing a short term crisis can call upon the Christian Support Center for guidance. The Center may provide assistance with paying utilities, offer basic needs such as clothing or food, and assist in tackling the cause of the crisis. They may provide rent assistance in an emergency for individuals facing an eviction. Also, they provide referrals to government grant programs and other agencies.

Our church has been asked to assist the food pantry by donating cereal and oatmeal. These staple items are always in need. Please place items in the tote in the Lobby.
