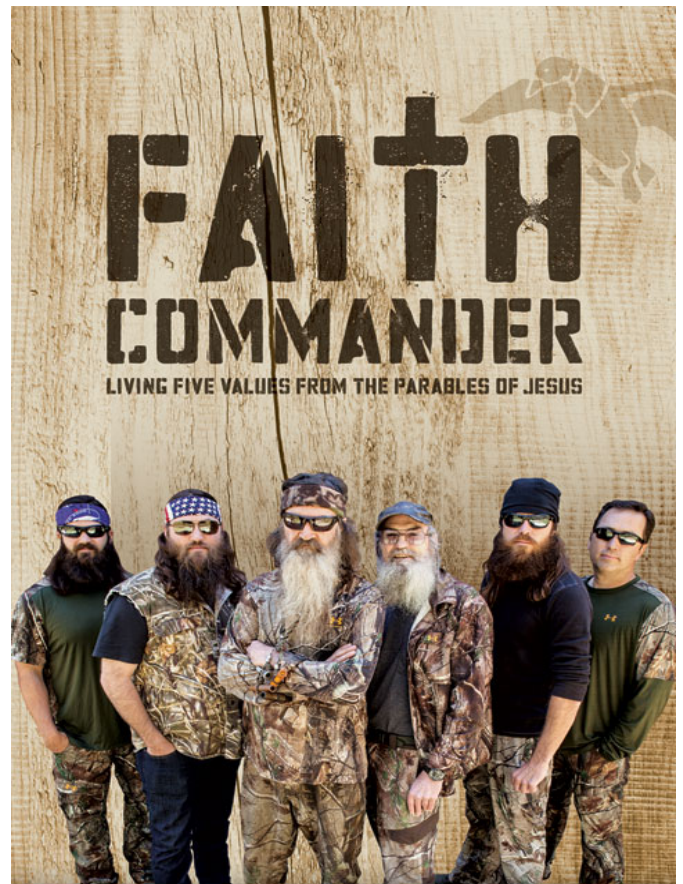

Bring a friend, remember your verses, bring a Bible and get registered for prizes. Registration starts each evening at 5:45 pm in the Church Lobby

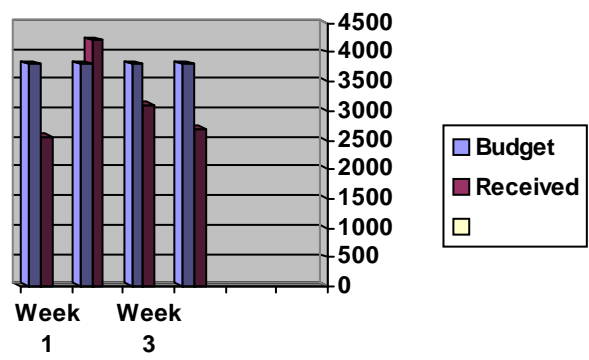
