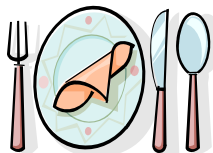

What Does Jesus Look Like?

The preschool teacher watched as the three year old little boy scribbled something on his paper. "What are you drawing?" she asked. "I'm drawing a picture of God," was the little boy's reply. "Oh, you can't do that," she said. "Nobody knows what God looks like." Without looking up, the boy answered, "Well, they will now."

Throughout our church on either paper or in paintings, we can find pictures of Jesus. Not actual pictures, but what people think Jesus looked like. I myself have a portrait of Jesus (artist's conception) in my office. How do we really know what Jesus looked like? I could say, think of my sermons on the "Soul Full of Fruit". He looks like the Fruit of the Spirit which are: love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. But the best portrait we have of Jesus is found in your mirror.

"And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit." 2 Corinthians 3:18

The more that we contemplate the Lord's glory, the more the Holy Spirit transforms us into the image of Jesus. We may never know what Jesus looked like on Earth. 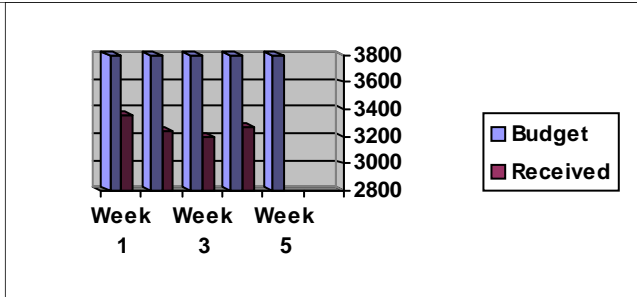
RECYCLING PROJECT

From the Missions Ministry

WRE is a program we here at Center have supported for many years. Because this is one of our supported ministries, here are a few facts about this ministry I'd like to share with you.

All four of Plainfield's elementary schools participate in this program. WRE meets each Tuesday morning from 9:00 AM to 11:45 a.m. with approximately 240 fourth grade students attending. We have six teachers, two worship leaders and seven bus drivers involved. About half of the students have no church affiliation. With the help of this program students become familiar with the Bible and how to use it.

WRE is under the umbrella of the Church Federation here in Plainfield. It costs nothing for the students to attend WRE, and we started the year with adequate funding, but continued support of this ministry is necessary. With your prayers and generous support, WRE can continue to service the youth with this most important outreach program.

ALL GIRLS GROUP TO BEGIN

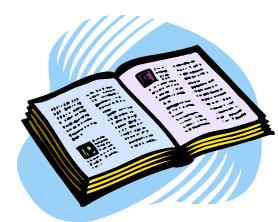
