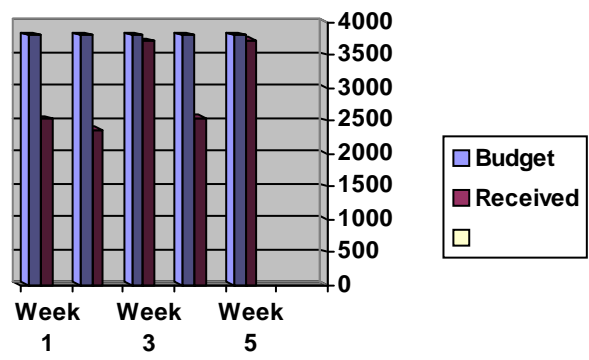

As the Missions Ministry is revamping mission support, we were wondering how “The Restore Church” was doing. This church was selected for support about three years ago.

The Minister is Aaron Thomas, with wife Karrie and three sons, Ty, 6 yrs., Will, 4 yrs., and Sutter, 2 yrs. Aaron is the grandson of Paul Ragsdale, the Pastor here at Center about forty years ago.

The Restore Church moved about three years ago to Silver Spring, MD. The Church started with four adults and had expanded to eleven in the first year. Now as they are entering their third year, this year’s Easter Service attendance was 168. The offering has been increasing steadily.

The Restore Church currently occupies a state-of-the-art venue called the Fillmore. With God’s help, The Church was able to negotiate a phenomenal monthly fee and their Sunday AM services are held there.

The Restore Church is currently in a fundraising effort and looking forward to expanding in an urban area there in Silver Spring.
